



Keep an eye on our Facebook for more information coming soon I am often asked how Respite Volunteers is doing when I am out and about in our community, and even more so lately. I always feel compelled to be honest and explain that we are doing pretty good considering the last two and a half years, but we need more volunteers, PLEASE. Our most valuable resource is our Volunteers! We would love if more of you reading this newsletter, who reside here in Shiawassee County, or close by, would please consider giving volunteering with Respite Volunteers a try. Literally an hour and a half of your time, most weeks can be life changing for the person with health challenges, their family caring for them, and it might even be life changing for you.

I am so very grateful to the persons and families that we are serving and have served that are willing to let others in their circle of friends and in their communities, know that they are receiving our services. It always gives me chills, to hear a family say just how important the volunteer is to them, and it is still just amazing to me how much help they feel when the volunteer visits only an hour and a half or a little more, most every week. Can't you please try this out? Isn't there a way to find just an hour and a half or so in your week?

There are multiple ways that you can help sustain our program, so that we may continue to serve persons and caregiving families asking for our help. We have returned to scheduled volunteer trainings outside the office, around the county. Please consider helping Respite Volunteers to be able to continue to provide the same friendly visiting and respite to the family caregivers. Maybe you could host a Respite Volunteer training at your church, or if you own a business, at your business.

I spent some time preparing to write this, and looked at some of our previous Fall Newsletters. I was encouraged by the obstacles we have faced, and how we have not only survived, but grown, with the help of our volunteers, and our community. We have made it through some tough times with the help of our volunteers, friends, families we have served and our community. So thank you all very much.

Our next in-person fundraiser will be a collaborative Raise Up Shiawassee fundraiser on Fri. Nov. 4th at the Lebowsky Center for Performing Arts, in Owosso. Raise Up Shiawassee is the local initiative for Giving Tuesday, made up of about 25 nonprofits, and foundations working together to fund services here in Shiawassee County. 


